

Veterinary requirements for horses taking part in horse racing in Poland

- I. For a horse to compete in Poland it is necessary to have received an approved equine influenza vaccination within the last 12 months.

Equine influenza vaccination schedule

1. Primary course of vaccination – two doses of vaccine administered between a minimum of 21 days to a maximum of 92 days apart.
2. Booster vaccinations must be given according to the manufacturer's instructions, but not later than 12 months after the latest vaccination
3. No booster vaccination can be given later than 7 days before a horse is to run in a race.

- II. For a horse to compete in Poland it is necessary to have a negative Coggins test carried out within 30 days before a horse is to run in a race.

Equine infectious anemia

1. A Coggins test for equine infectious anemia with a negative result carried out within 30 days prior to a horse's taking part in a race.
2. The date of the latest serological test for equine infectious anemia must be confirmed in a horse's passport by an approved veterinarian.
