Veterinary requirements for horses taking part in horse racing in Poland

I. For a horse to compete in Poland it is necessary to have received an approved equine infulenza vaccination within the last 12 months.

Equine influenza vaccination schedule

- 1. Primary course of vaccination two doses of vaccine administered between a minimum of 21 days to a maximum of 92 days apart.
- 2. Booster vaccinations must be given according to the manufacutre's instructions, but not later that 12 months after the latest vaccination
- 3. No booster vaccination can be given later than 7 days before a horse is to run in a race.
- II. For a horse to compete in Poland it is necessary to have a negative Coggins test carried out within 30 days before a horse is to run in a race.

Equine infectious anemia

- 1. A Coggins test for euquine infectious anemia with a negative result carried out within 30 days prior to a horse's taking part in a race.
- 2. The date of the latest serological test for euquine infectious anemia must be confirmed in a horse's passport by an approved veterinarian.
