II. Participants: Riders who are not using traditional bridles and bites

Participants will compete in both the OPEN category and in categories listed below:

- 1. Senior 18yo and older
- 2. Junior 10-17yo
 - 2.1 ponies (up to 149 cm)
 - 2.2 horses (more than 149cm)
 - (Attention! All the Juniors must have parents' or legal guardian)

In the case of a small number of participants enroled in a given category, the Organizer has the right to carry on competitions in the OPEN category (this does not apply to the show jumping competition - division into ponies and horses).

IV. Requirements:

1. Riders

1.1 Documents:

- competitors are required to have valid medical examinations confirming the lack of contraindications to participate in the competition or submitting a declaration that there are no health contraindications to participate in the competition.

1.2 Dress code:

- in all disciplines in the junior category, the mandatory headgear is a protective helmet with three-point closure,
- in show jumping, all competitors are required to wear protective helmets, and competitors under the age of 15 also have to wear protective vests. However, all participants are recommended to wear headgear in the form of a protective helmet with a three-point closure,
- it is allowed to use whips and spurs described as allowed in the PZJ regulations for respective disciplines,
- in the Liberty Trail, Dressage Show, and Jumping competitions, any neat and clean outfit of the riders is allowed,
- the judges' commission has the right to intervene in situations that may endanger the safety of the rider or the horse.


2. Horses

2.1 Documents:

- vaccinations against equine influenza with certified entries in the passport are required. Revaccination cannot take place later than 7 days before arrival at the competition. Horses without valid vaccinations will not be admitted to the WTWK-Partynice area!
- PZHK/PZJ/FEI passport

2.2 Riding equipment:

- The competition is held without traditional bridles and bits, in a traditional saddle (English, Western, Hungarian, etc.) or in a bareback saddle/pad,
- During a run, the horse must not wear any bridle, halter or cavessan,
- breast plate and protective boots are allowd in showjumping and liberty trail
- It is allowed to use the so-called cordeo, i.e. a belt with a closed circumference, not attached to the saddle in any way. Cordeo must be below the trachea level during the entire run!



- The horse may wear a gentle halter in the warm up arena (bridles, hackamore, bosal, halter made of sharp strings, etc. are not allowed). The judges may check the used bite and, depending on their decision, admonish the competitors or eliminate them from the start in the competition.,

- It is allowed for a competitor to participate in more than one competition within a given age group, on different or on the same horse, where one horse may take part in a maximum of three competitions on one day, and a pair of horse/rider in up to two competitions.
- In matters not covered by these proposals, the regulations of PZJ disciplines (Dressage Show and Jumping) and WEP/WAWE (Liberty Trail) regulations apply.

If the competition is held in the OPEN category, the fees for the SENIOR category will apply. Straw and hay for horses are available free of charge in the competition area.

COMPLAINTS AND PROTESTS - In consultation with other committee members, the main judge decides all complaints and protests made by competitors. The main judge's decisions are final and cannot be appealed. The protest/complaint must be submitted in writing to the competition office, no later than 30 minutes after the end of the competition to which the protest/complaint relates (Friday, Saturday) and 15 minutes after the end of the final competition to which the protest/complaint relates (Sunday), together with a deposit of **300 PLN** (returnable in case of positive approval). The protest should be examined no later than 1 hour after the last competition's end on the day the protest/complaint is submitted.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

- 1. At all stages of the horse's training and preparation for competition, the welfare of the horse must be above all other requirements. This applies to constant care, training methods, careful grooming, shoeing, and transport.
- 2. Horses and riders must be trained, competent, and healthy before participating in the competition. This also applies to the administration of medications, surgeries that endangers the welfare of the horse or the pregnancy of the mare, and abuse of aids
- **3.** Competition must not endanger the welfare of the Horse. This requires paying special attention to the competition area, ground surface, weather, stable conditions, the condition of the horses, and their safety, also during the return journey from the competition.
- **4.** Every effort should be made to ensure that horses are cared for after the end of the competition, as well as after the end of their sporting career. This applies to proper veterinary care of injuries sustained during competitions, peaceful old age, or possible euthanasia.
- **5.** The organizer encourages all people active in equestrian sport to constantly improve their knowledge and skills regarding all aspects of cooperation with the horse.
